## Subject: <u>Applications for thirteen vacancies of mandate holders to be appointed at the 43rd session of the Human Rights Council</u>

The Secretariat of the Human Rights Council presents its compliments to all Permanent Missions to the United Nations Office at Geneva, international organizations or their offices, national institutions, non-governmental organizations and other human rights bodies, and has the honour to inform them that the following thirteen mandate holders are to be appointed at the forty-third session of the Council (24 February to 20 March 2020):

- 1. Expert Mechanism on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (EMRIP), member from the Arctic [HRC res. 33/25]
- 2. Expert Mechanism on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (EMRIP), member from Asia [HRC res. 33/25]
- 3. Independent Expert on the effects of foreign debt and other related international financial obligations of States on the full enjoyment of all human rights, particularly economic, social and cultural rights [HRC res. 34/3]<sup>1</sup>
- 4. Independent Expert on the enjoyment of all human rights by older persons  $[HRC res. 33/5]^1$
- 5. Independent Expert on the situation of human rights in Somalia [HRC res. 39/23]<sup>1</sup>
- 6. Special Rapporteur on adequate housing as a component of the right to an adequate standard of living, and on the right to non-discrimination in this context [HRC res. 34/9]<sup>1</sup>
- 7. Special Rapporteur on contemporary forms of slavery, including its causes and its consequences  $[HRC res. 33/1]^1$
- 8. Special Rapporteur on extreme poverty and human rights [HRC res. 35/19]
- 9. Special Rapporteur on the right to food [HRC res. 40/7]
- 10. Special Rapporteur on the rights of indigenous peoples [HRC res. 33/12]<sup>1</sup>
- 11. Special Rapporteur on the sale and sexual exploitation of children, including child prostitution, child pornography and other child sexual abuse material [HRC res. 34/16]<sup>1</sup>
- 12. Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights defenders [HRC res. 34/5]<sup>1</sup>
- 13. Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Myanmar [HRC res. 40/29]<sup>1</sup>
