Special Rapporteur on the right to food	Report presented to the 74th session of the UNGA in 2019 on the SDGs as a potentially transformative tool to advance the realization of the right to food, as well as other economic, social and cultural rights, explaining that some SDGs might require tradeoffs in between them, in particular between SDGs 3, 12, and 15, which suggest that countries will either invest in better health care or environmental protections and responsible consumption and production, but not all three, and that guaranteeing the right to adequate quality and quantity as part of the right to food requires looking beyond productivism under SDG 2 and recognizing positive links to land and ocean ecosystem health (SDGs 14 and 15) and that and that the SDG framework promotes a view of gender equality that is too limiting, failing to mention women in certain SDGs, such as SDG 15 (A/74/164).
