

Subject: RE: World Programme for Human Rights Education - Consultation on the 5th phase

About target groups

- Focus on human rights and agency (for human rights/education) of vulnerable and disadvantaged groups in society, i.e. those experiencing most difficulties in accessing human rights (including human rights education) including people/populations victims of armed conflict. This would mean (young) people experiencing discrimination, including forms of intersectional discrimination, (young) people from disadvantaged neighbourhoods or communities, Roma, refugees, LGBTI. And people affected by armed conflict and its consequences.

Coming from the youth sector we favour a focus on youth; yet, there are also concerns of involving the most obvious stakeholders, that is the school environment: children and young people, the whole school community (in the fashion of the whole school approach).

Thematic human rights issues:

- Human rights (education) in the digital environment, or more generally the questions of digitalisation and their relation with human rights (education);
- Human rights (education) and the climate and environmental crisis/justice.
