Target Sectors	Children with disabilities, and children of under- privileged families	The Ministry of Education has recognized the rights of students with disabilities to access general educations, and therefore the rights to obtain similar opportunities to education and livelihood as other children.  The Ministry of Education also recognizes the rights of students who are underprivileged to ensure their well-
		being and access to education.  Recognizing the importance of human rights of children to access, participate and achieve in education as the important elements of inclusive education and equity, therefore, the Ministry of Education suggests to target these groups of rights holders viz. children with disabilities and children of under-privileged families.
Focus Areas or Thematic Human Rights Issues	Full participation in society of children with disabilities, children of under- privileged families	The Ministry of Education recognizes that disabilities and poverty are some barriers to participation in society. Families living with children with disabilities and families living in poverty are vulnerable to environment changes (due to natural disasters or diseases).
		Therefore, the Ministry of Education promotes and facilitates the efforts of the Government of Brunei Darussalam's whole-nation approach to support the children with disabilities, and children of underprivileged families to access basic human rights. Hence, the Ministry of Education suggests to focus their full participation in society of these important basic human right issues.
