

Pledge submitted by Angola to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat December 2023

Original language of submission: English Type of pledge: Single (by one state/actor) Pledging entity: Ministry of External Relations of Angola

PLEDGE NUMBER 1: Conclude International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearence ratification process and schedule the country visit of the Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disapparearance: The ratification process is expected to be concluded by December 2024 and the country visit is scheduled to take place in March 2024.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2024

PLEDGE NUMBER 2: Strengthen the dialogue with UN Special Procedures and Treaty Bodies through the presentation of reports: This is an ongoing task due to Angola's international obligations in terms of human rights.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Ongoing task

PLEDGE NUMBER 3: Develop and implement the National Education Policy for a culture of Human Rights: The adoption of the national policy is introduced in the framework of the National Strategy of Human Rights and is anticipated for December 2024

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2024

PLEDGE NUMBER 4: Strengthen the partnership with civil society organizations and carry out joint actions in matters of human rights: It will mainly involve organizing 16 provincial conferences of Local Human Rights Committees, as well as 16 capacity building workshops for members of said Committees. This initiative will also result in the integration of civil society organizations into local committees.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2024

PLEDGE NUMBER 5: Strengthen national institutions of human rights, of agreement with the principles of Paris Angola plans to have a National Human Rights Institution in line with the Paris Principles by 2025.
