

## Pledge submitted by Ethiopia to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat December 2023

Original language of submission: English Type of pledge: Single (by one state/actor) Pledging entity: The Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia

**Pledge Number 1:** To develop, validate, adopt, and commence the implementation of a victimcentered, genuine, participatory, inclusive, and comprehensive national transitional justice policy which is grounded on applicable international and regional human rights standards and principles (adoption by the end of 2023; implementation to start in early 2024).

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: May 30, 2024

**Pledge Number 2:** To adopt and implement the third National Human Rights Action Plans which prioritizes civil and political rights as its main focus areas.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: May 30, 2024

**Pledge Number 3:** To provide capacity-building training based on international and regional standards and best Practices on techniques of investigating atrocity crimes, including conflict-related sexual violence, to prosecutors and police officers (by first quarter of 2024)

**Pledge Number 4:** To enact a comprehensive legislation on the crime of torture in line with the Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (CAT) to which Ethiopia is a party to since 1994.

**Pledge Number 5:** To enact a comprehensive legal framework and working procedures to implement the recently inaugurated National Free Legal Aid Strategy.
