

Pledge submitted by the Principality of Liechtenstein to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat December 2023

Original language of submission: English

Type of pledge: Single (by one state/actor)

Pledging entity: Government of the Principality of Liechtenstein

PLEDGE NUMBER 1: Liechtenstein will continue to implement its international human rights treaty obligations, including by giving special attention to the implementation of the obligations set forth in the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 10, 2028

PLEDGE NUMBER 2: Liechtenstein will continue to advocate strongly for the full respect of international humanitarian law and international human rights law, by also continuing to explore avenues to bring perpetrators of international criminal law to justice.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 10, 2028

PLEDGE NUMBER 3: Liechtenstein will continue to attach highest importance to the inclusion of civil society actors, both nationally and internationally, and will continue to make budgetary means in its International Humanitarian Cooperation and Development available for the protection of civil society and human rights defenders.
