

Pledge submitted by Luxembourg and Mexico to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat December 2023

In the next five years, this cross-regional pledge from xxx Member States commits to advancing the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in four ways:

PLEDGE NUMBER 1: Continuing to uphold the universality, indivisibility, interdependence, and interrelatedness of all human rights and fundamental freedoms, treating them in a fair and equal manner.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2028

PLEDGE NUMBER 2: Ensuring that progressivity and non-regression remain a fundamental part of achieving all human rights enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2028

PLEDGE NUMBER 3: Striving to end multiple and intersecting forms of discrimination, coercion, violence, and the denial of the full realization of human rights for all individuals by advancing human rights standards.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2028

PLEDGE NUMBER 4: Defending and advancing human rights processes and international and regional instruments including, the ICPD Programme of Action and Beijing Platform for Action and their review conferences; particularly in the face of the pushback on gender equality and sexual and reproductive health and rights, and efforts to instrumentalize these mechanisms through a narrow and restrictive lens.
