PLEDGE NUMBER 1: Our world is aging fast, yet older persons are invisible in the international human rights framework, providing inadequate coverage of their rights. A legally binding international convention on the rights of older persons is the best way to address these gaps. CNPEA pledges to organise a multi-stakeholder meeting/webinar for the Age with Rights Global Rally in February 2024 to advocate for a UN convention and call for our government to participate in the next OEWG on Ageing. We will encourage our 1,000+ members to support the global call for a new UN convention on the rights of older persons.
