

Pledge submitted by the International Organization for Migration (IOM) to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat December 2023

Original language of submission: English Type of pledge: Single (by one state/actor) Pledging entity: International Organization for Migration

Half of the world's population—3.6 billion people—are already highly vulnerable to climate change impacts. Displacement can bring some of the most consequential human rights impacts.

PLEDGE NUMBER 1: IOM commits to carry forward the work we delivered together that enabled countries at COP28 to operationalize a new fund for loss and damage (nearly \$800 million) to address climate change impacts.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2025

PLEDGE NUMBER 2: IOM is stepping up using its evidence and data to foresee, prevent and trigger early action. In Africa alone, we aim to train state officials on migrants' rights from at least 20 states and 50 states globally.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2025

PLEDGE NUMBER 3: IOM pledges to further support States to expand regular pathways for migrants and enable people-centered, rights-based approaches to migration governance.
