PLEDGE NUMBER 1: The Jadir Taekwondo Association commits to launching a community-driven Taekwondo initiative aimed at promoting inclusivity and tolerance among 300 children and youth in underserved areas of Rio de Janeiro. Over the next 10 months, we will conduct weekly Taekwondo sessions, involving 50 participants in each session, and integrate discussions on human rights, diversity, and social harmony. To ensure the project's success, we will establish partnerships with local schools and community centers, leveraging certified Taekwondo instructors and involving parents to ensure sustained participation. Our goal is not only to enhance participants' physical fitness through Taekwondo but also to deepen their understanding of human rights, thereby contributing to a more harmonious and rights-respecting society. The program will commence in February 2024 and conclude in November 2024, culminating in a closing event that will highlight participants' achievements and underscore the importance of human rights in building united and inclusive communities.
