PLEDGE NUMBER 1: By end of 2026, the Swedish Institute for Human Rights has carried out a broad public information campaign on the standards and complaints mechanisms relevant to human rights enshrined in the Universal Declaration. The campaign has had a focus on groups in vulnerable situations or with specific information needs. By end of 2027, there has been a follow-up to the campaign, pointing to an increase in the level of human rights awareness among the targeted audience, compared to the results recently presented in the Institute's 2023 baseline survey.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 10, 2027

PLEDGE NUMBER 2: By end of 2025, the Institute has carried out studies and collated testimonies on the nature and consequences of hate, threats and prejudices among members of national, ethnic and religious minorities as well as other groups in vulnerable situations, emanating in recommendations to government and other duty-bearers on measures needed for improving the right to safety. By end of 2027, the Institute has followed-up on the impact of these recommendations, in dialogue with concerned rights-holders.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 10, 2027
