I refer to your letter dated 25 July 2016 requesting input from the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) concerning "*best practices and major challenges in addressing the negative effects of terrorism on the enjoyment of all human rights and fundamental freedoms, particularly the right to life, liberty and security of person*" for a report to be prepared pursuant to Resolution 31/30 of the Human Rights Council on "Effects of terrorism on the enjoyment of all human rights".

We have carefully considered the request for input and, bearing in mind the nature of FAO's mandate and activities, we have not been able to identify data on best practices and major challenges of the kind requested. Accordingly, I regret that, in this instance, we are unable to provide you with information.
