Dr. Abdel-Moneim is currently Associate Professor of International Law and Organization at Port-Said University; he was Associate Professor at Suez Canal University from 1992 to 2013; he taught international law and organizations at Al-Azhar University from 2005 to 2012; he was Lecturer on International Human Rights Law at the Programme for Capacity-Building on Human Rights, UNDP, Egypt from 2006 to 2011.

He is also Member of the UN Committee on Economic Social Cultural Rights (CESCR); he was Vice-Chairman of the Committee from 2009 to2011) and Chairman of the Joint Expert Group of UNCESCR and UNESCO on the Right to Education in 2011.

Dr. Abdel-Moneim was Member of National Committee for Economic, Social and Cultural Rights from 2006 to 2008; member of the Board of Directors of the Center for Future Studies at Suez Canal University from 1996 to 2004; member of the Board of Directors of the Centre of Political and International Studies at the Faculty of Economics in Cairo University from 1996 to 2004; member of the American Society of International Law from 1987 to 1996.

He was member of the Committee on Economic Legal and Political Studies at the Supreme Council for Higher Education from 2004 to 2009; member of the Egyptian Committee for the Promotion of International Humanitarian Law (1996-2004) and adviser to the Chairman of the National Council on Human Rights (2005). Adviser to Secretary General of the League of Arab States; Assistant to Foreign Minister for Multilateral Affairs from 2002 to 2005; member of the General Directorate for Economic Research, Cairo (1967-1969).

Dr. Abdel-Moneim has been lecturer on International Organization at Faculty of Economics Cairo University since 1994; Lecturer on Non-Governmental Organizations at same university from 2007 to present. From 1987 to 1991 he was Alternate Representative to UN Office Vienna, on matters related to Refugees, Women, the Elderly and Crime Prevention. He contributed to proceedings of the Inter-Regional Consultations on Social Welfare Policies, UN, Vienna in 1982 and to the Drafting of Human Rights-related resolutions and documents adopted by multilateral forums including UN, NAM, and OIC from 1994 to 2004.
