

Information regarding the resolution of the United Nations Human Rights Council 19/20

Human Resources Management Authority in its annual training program, which consists of various modules, there are a few trainings related to the promotion of human rights. Training courses are designed in the form of lectures followed by workshops, case studies and practical examples.

In the Module of the **European and Euro-Atlantic integration** there are two trainings in the field of human rights: „**European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms**“ and „**European Court of Human Rights**“. These courses are intended for all civil servants that show an interest in such a topic. The goal of these trainings is to introduce the practical application of European Convention on Human Rights such as composition, jurisdiction and practice of European Court of Human Rights. Further, by attending these trainings civil servants acquire new knowledge of the fundamental rights and freedoms, get opportunities to learn about the position of the European Convention on Human Rights in the EU countries and its relationship with the EU acquis, awareness of the judgments of the European Court of Human Rights to the practice of national courts, the knowledge of monitoring mechanisms of the Council of Europe etc.

In the Module **Constitution and policy of equal opportunities** there is subject „**The Human Rights and Freedoms Ombudsman**“, which is primarily aimed at civil servants who deal with certain issues in the field of human rights and freedoms, as well as all other interested civil servants. The benefits obtained by attending this training are: strengthening the accountability of civil servants to respect human rights and freedoms, human rights standards through the procedure of their administrative and judicial protection, recognition of role of The Human Rights and Freedoms Ombudsman in relation to the work performance in administration as well as responsibility for omissions made in work, knowledge of possible consequences at the national and international level in case of violation of human rights and freedoms etc.
