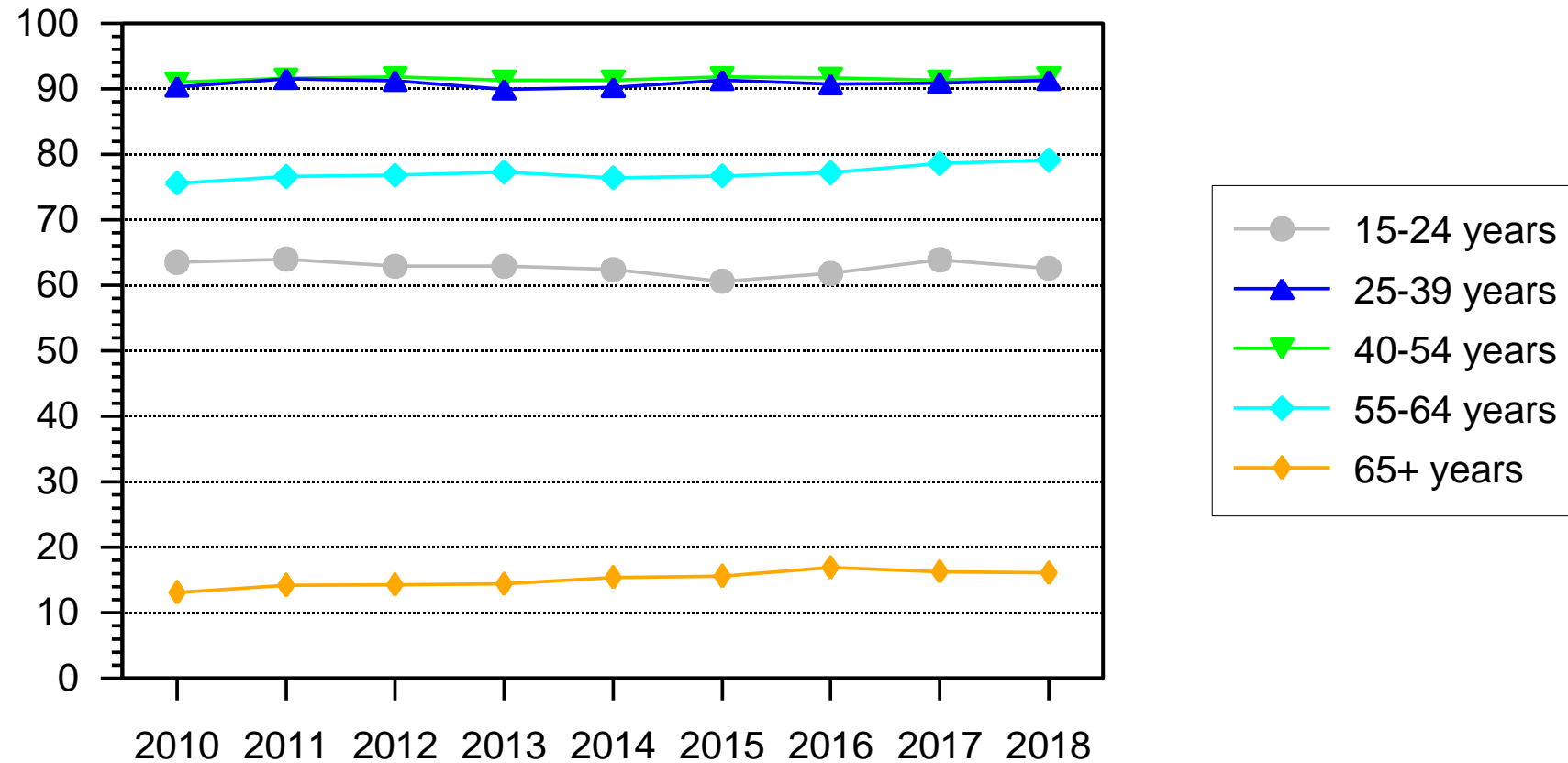

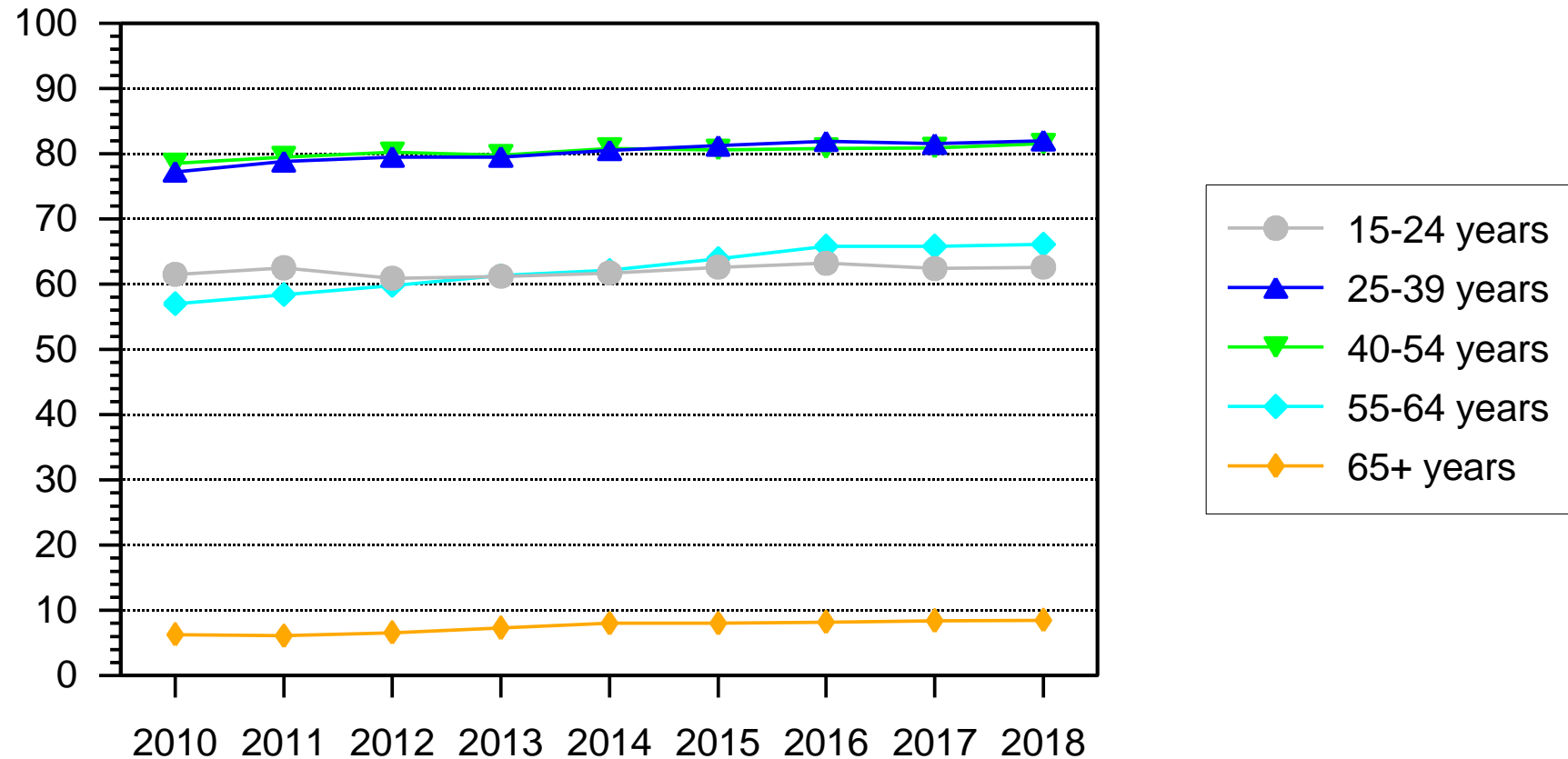
Switzerland: Employment rate by age, men, in %

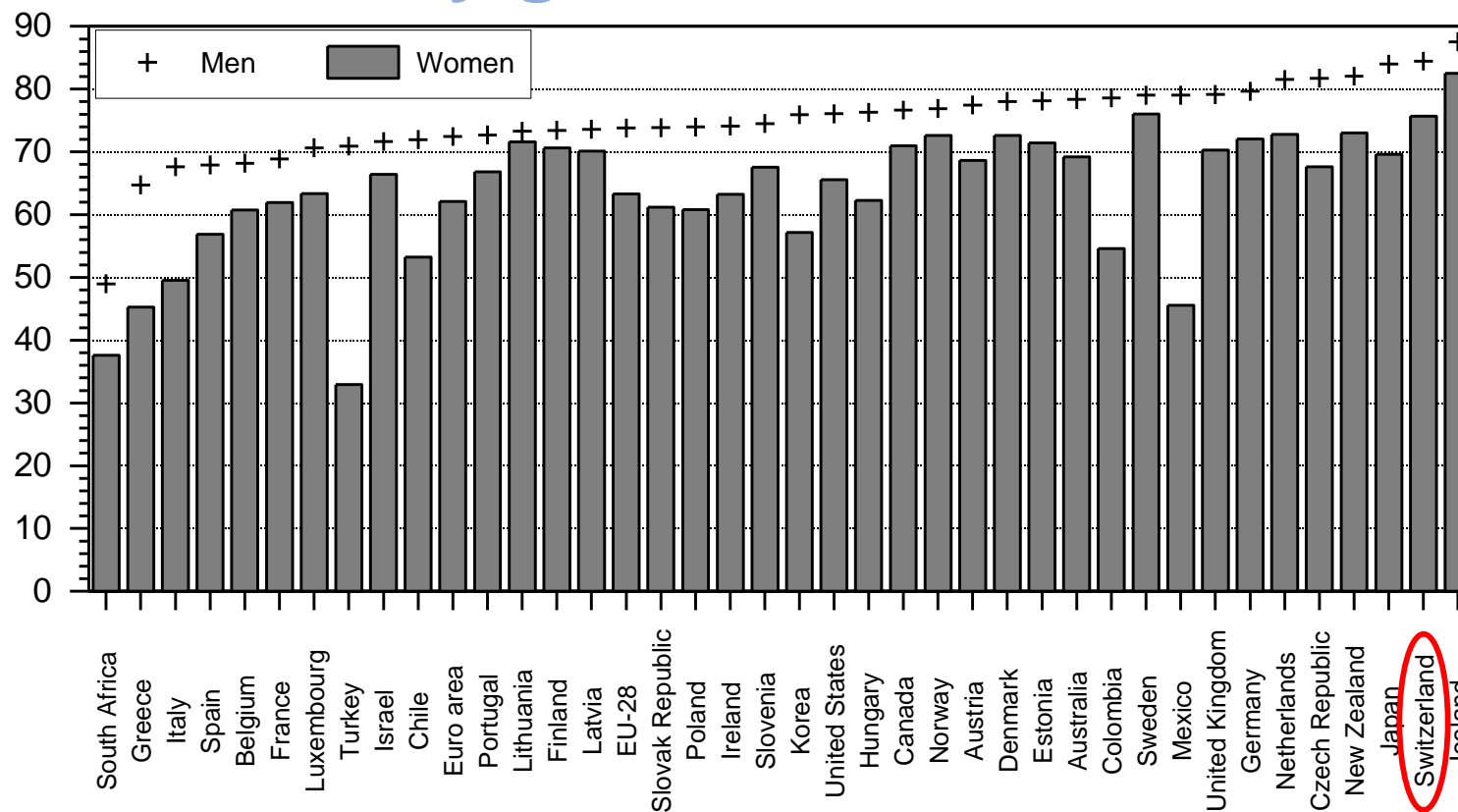
Switzerland: Employment rate by age, women, in %

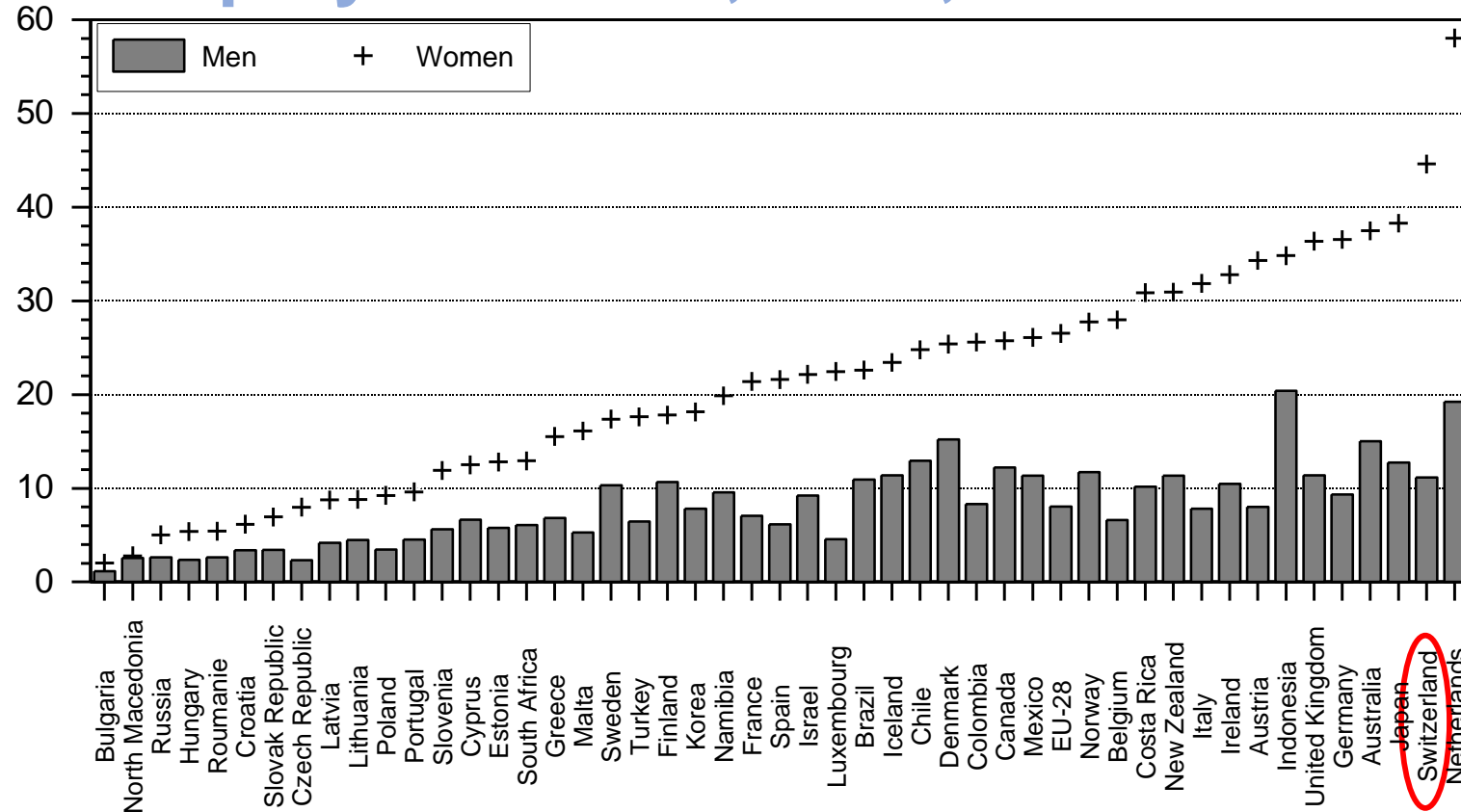
Employment rate by gender, 2018, in %

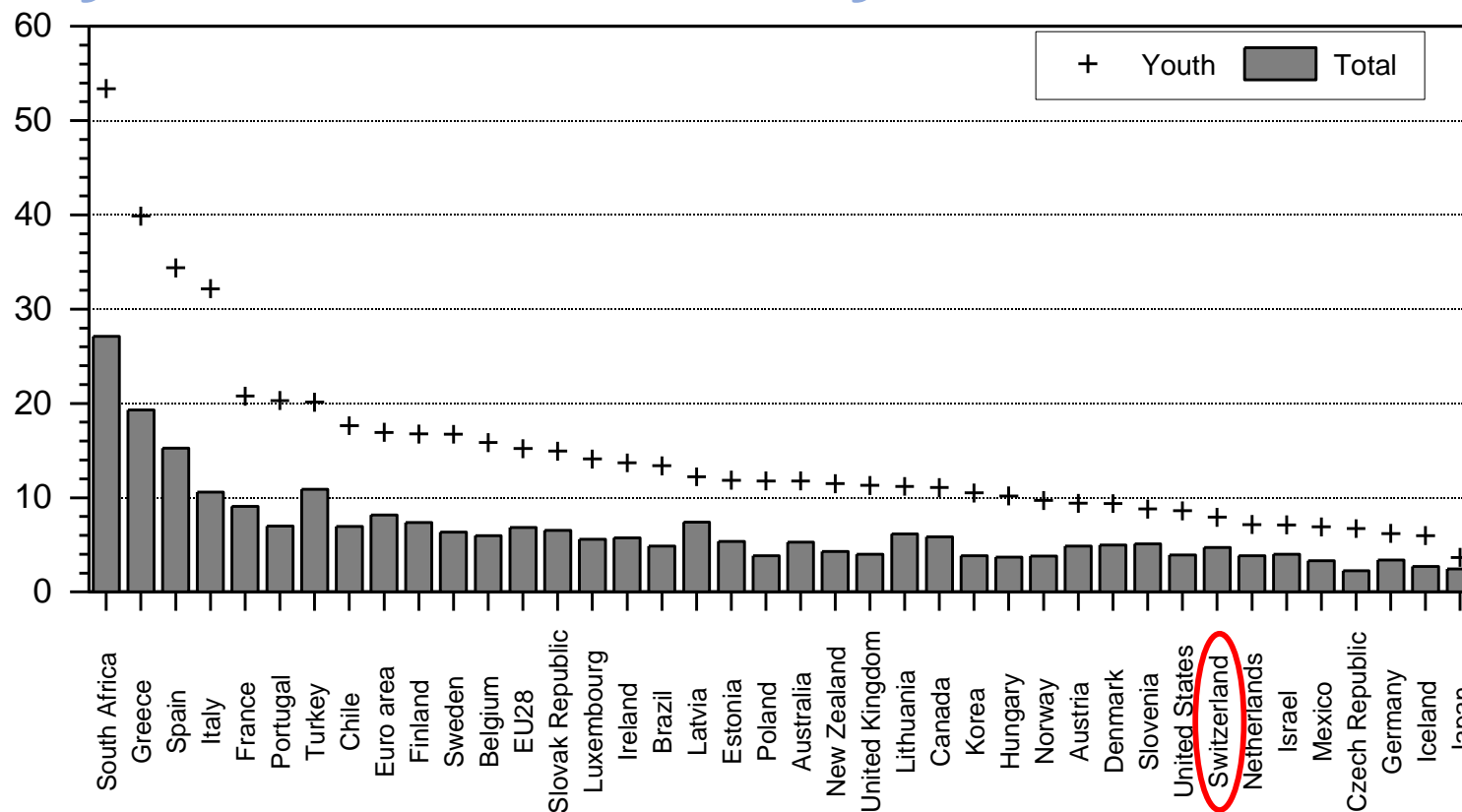
Part-time employment rate, 2018, in %

Unemployment rate total and youth, 2018, in %

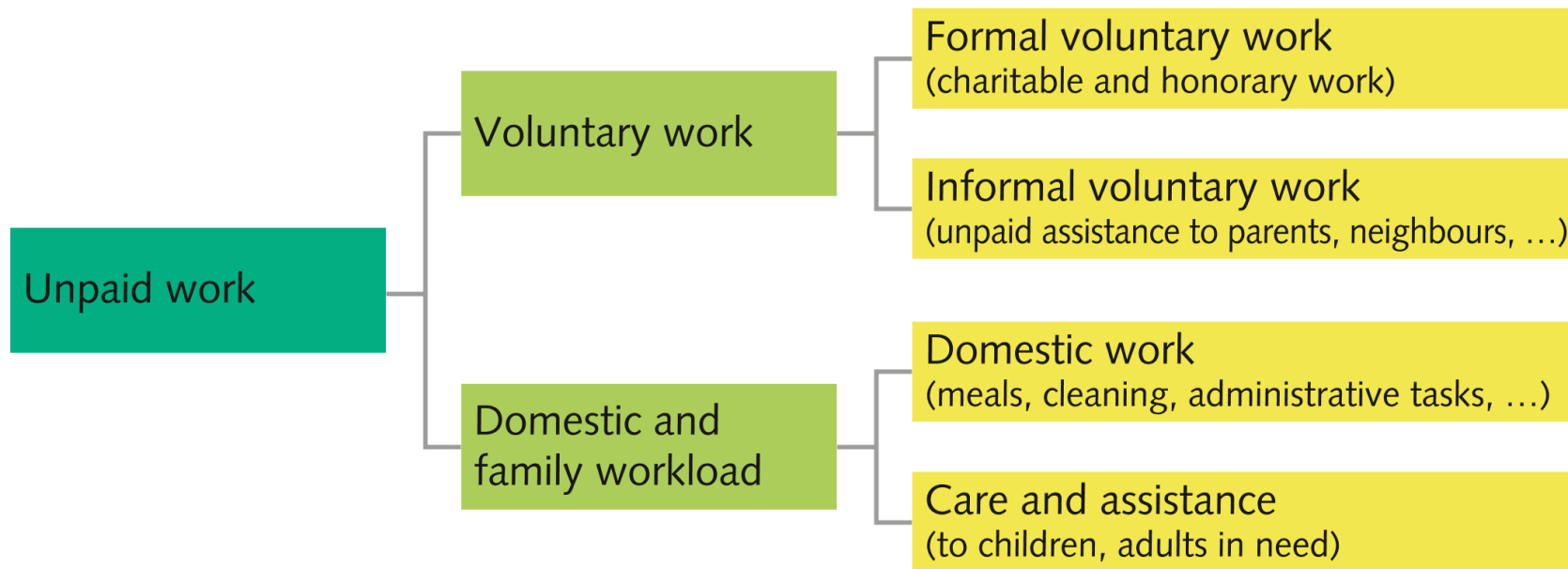

Unpaid work

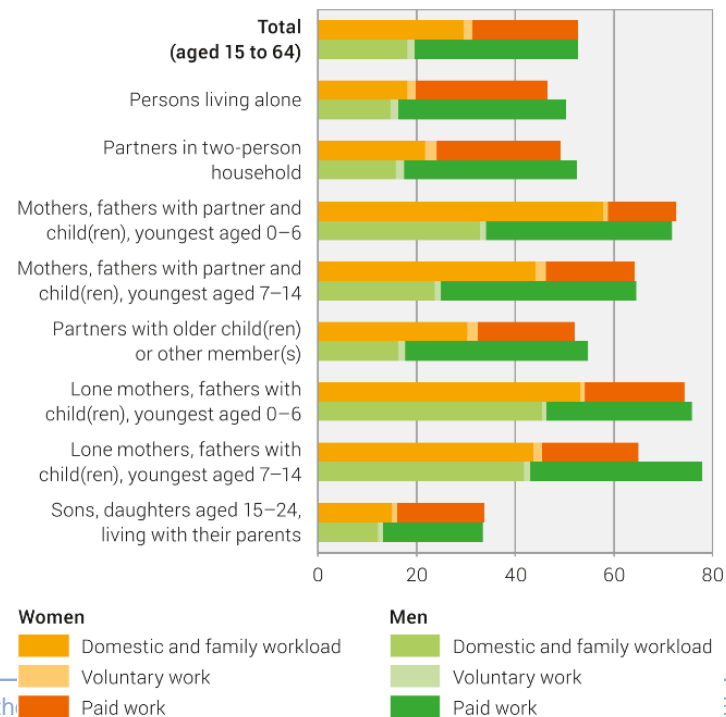




Women spend most time on domestic and family work while Men devote most time to paid work

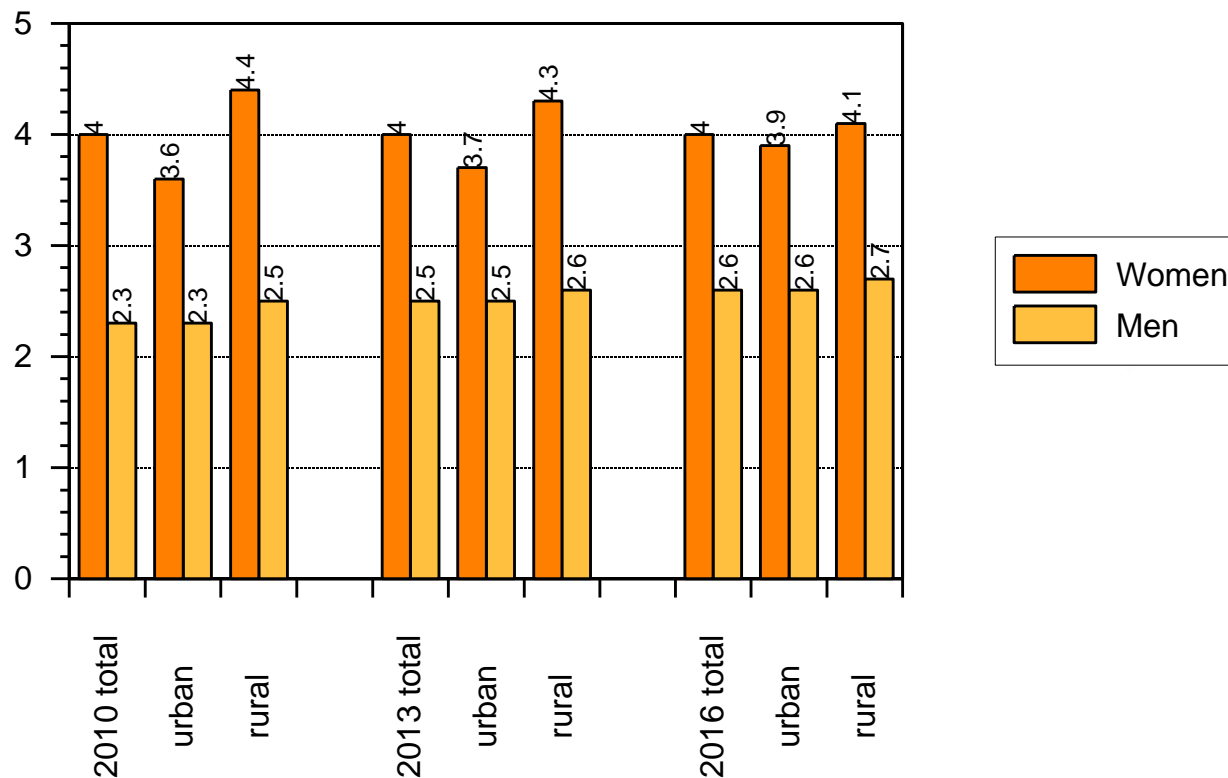
Time spent on paid work, on domestic and family workload and on voluntary work, 2016

Women spend more time on domestic and family work than men



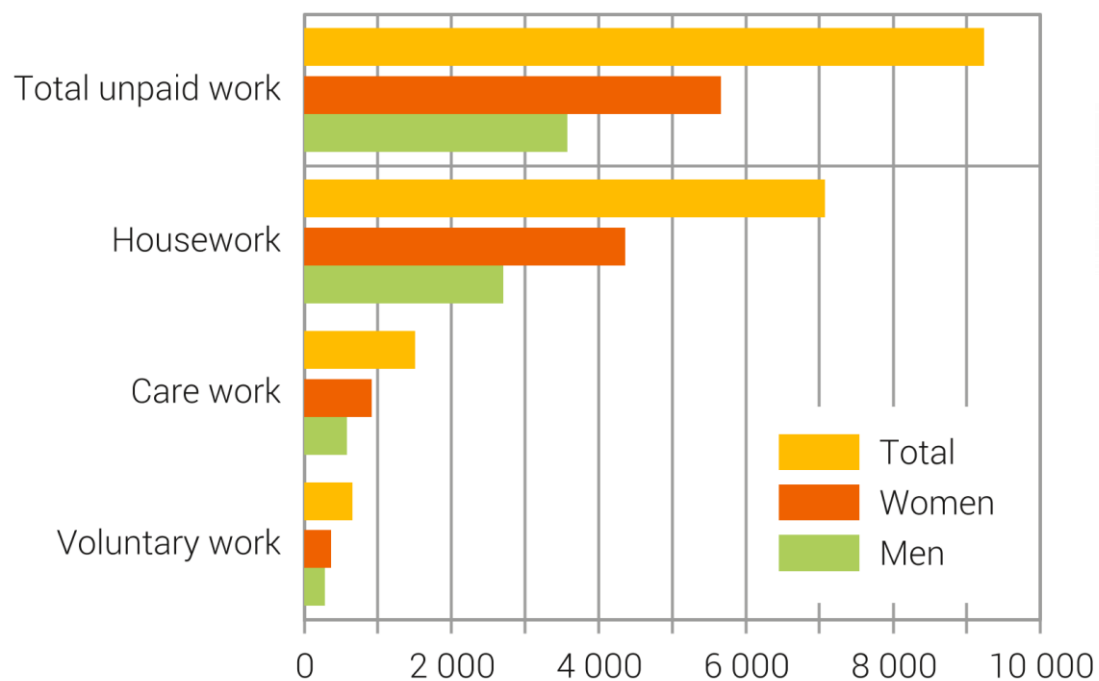

In millions of hours, permanent resident population aged 15 and over

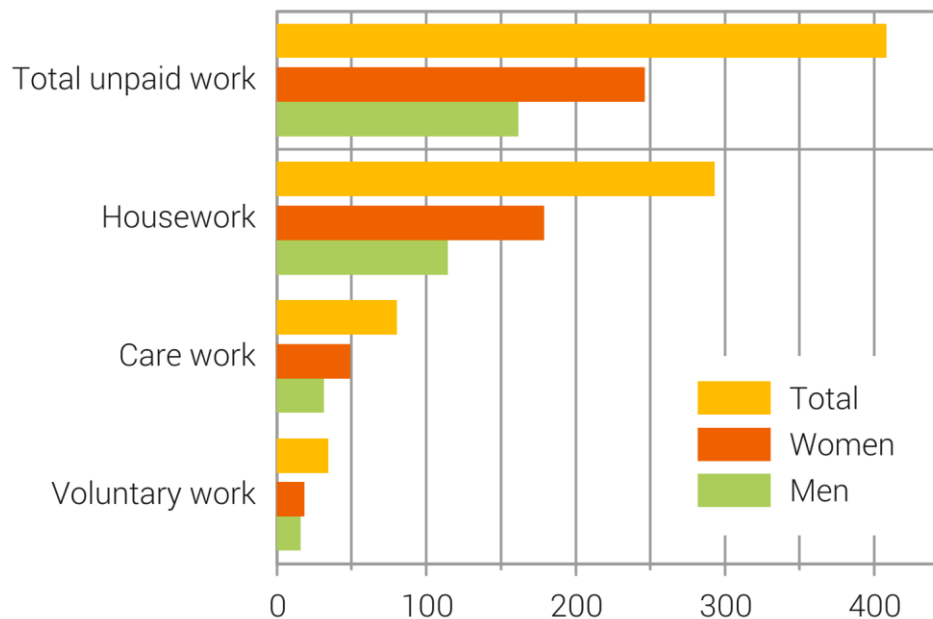




The total amount of unpaid work performed in 2016 is estimated to have a monetary value of CHF 408 billion.
