The Equality and Human Rights Commission has recently revamped its human rights pages, so if you go to our main website (URL: <u>https://www.equalityhumanrights.com/en</u>), and click on the "human rights" tab, you will see the resources we have available. In the "What are human rights?" section, we have produced a video explaining what human rights are and how they came about. We also have a section called 'Human rights stories' with videos of how individuals have used human rights to improve their lives, produced by Equally Ours, a campaigning network of human rights charities. There is also a section on the Universal Declaration, with a video produced by Amnesty International, and a section on the European Convention.
