The Permanent Mission of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the United Nations at Geneva presents its compliments to the United Nations Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights, and, referring to the Note Verbal number RRDD/DSEIB/METS/PM/EP/OU, dated February 1st 2013, and request for relevant information on “World Program for Human Rights Education” has the honor to transmit the following response of the Ministry of Civil Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina:

- (1) “*the target sector*” should be education and civil service sectors and in that sense target groups should be educators, teachers, professors and civil servants at all levels;
- (2) For “*focus areas or thematic human rights issues*” Ministry of Civil Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina suggested “Prohibition of discrimination in achieving all human rights and freedoms, especially the right to education” and special training for teachers working with children belonging to minorities, migrant families and children with disabilities.

The Permanent Mission of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the United Nations in Geneva avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the United Nations Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights the assurances of its highest consideration.
