INFORMATION ABOUT NATIONAL LEGISLATION APPLYING TO PRIVATE MILITARY AND SECURITY COMPANIES

In the Republic of Serbia, there are several laws which prescribe criminal measures for private military and/or security companies, including the competence of state criminal courts over crimes committed abroad by legal or natural persons from the Republic of Serbia¹. These laws are as follows:

- 1. Criminal Code of the Republic of Serbia²
- 2. Law on the Liability of Legal Entities for Criminal Offences³
- 3. Law on Organisation and Competence of State Authorities in Fighting Organised Crime, Corruption and Other Forms of Serious Crimes⁴
- 4. Law on Seizure and Confiscation of the Proceeds from Crime⁵
- 5. Criminal Procedure Code⁶
- 6. Criminal Procedure Code⁷
