Option 1. Register as a speaker on the Interprefy platform

The statement should not exceed 3 mins (4 mins for joint statements) and the email should indicate for which day of the session the intervention is intended.

Given these constraints, the Working Group will follow the order of speakers of the Human Rights Council as follows, 1.) Member States (Members of the Human Rights Council), 2.) Member States (Observers), and 3.) Civil society. We would like to secure the widest possible participation and we welcome group statements. All speakers will receive confirmation of their presence on the speakers list and the modalities of the discussion prior to the 27th session.
