On 27-28 May, the Special Rapporteur will present his annual report to the Human Rights Council. The report presents the findings of the Special Rapporteur’s yearlong regional study on the management of the external borders of the European Union (EU) and its impact on the human rights of migrants.

The aim of the side event is to engage in a constructive dialogue with Member States, the EU, international organizations, civil society organizations and other stakeholders on how to implement the recommendations in the report, by defining concrete actions for follow-up.

The side event will begin with a short presentation by the Special Rapporteur of the main conclusions and recommendations in his report, followed by a presentation by each of the panelists on possible actions for follow-up.
