

Perceptions and attitudes of the

High School Teachers towards LGBTI

adolescents in Schools in Albania



### General information on the survey study

The findings and observations of the survey study "Perceptions and attitudes of the High School Teachers towards LGBTI adolescents in Schools in Albania" is the first serious effort to get to know the situation of attitudes and discrimination of LGBTI adolescents attending public high schools in six major cities of Albania.

This is the first survey on such area of education. As such in our opinion it is considerable step in a new field of scientific studies in the country, on sexuality, homophobia and transphobia, bullying and violence against LGBTI adolescents in schools, and finally attitudes and perceptions of teachers working and teaching in public high school in Albania.



### General information on the geographical area of the survey

The survey was supported by the United States Embassy's Democracy Commission's Small Grants Program in Albania. Part of the support was also the organization of information sessions for teachers in six main geographical areas in the study.

The study gathered data in structured meetings with teachers in the following cities: Tirana, Durrës, Elbasan, Korça, Vlora and Shkodra. The population of these cities jointly represents almost two-thirds of the population in Albania. Thus the attitudes presented in the survey are also in a way indicative of the overall attitudes of the population in these urban centers.



# Adolescents in High Schools and the pre-university education system in Albania

### General data on adolescents in Albania

- There are no data available for LGBTI adolescents in Albania. Thus it was almost impossible from our surveillance to establish a general opinion based on comparative data, background documents or previous analysis.
- There is also lack of data on sexual behaviour in both adolescents and adults in Albania. There are no studies currently in Albania that have looked into the sexual behaviour and attitudes towards sexual rights of the general population, and therefore our data is not representative as they cannot be compared to previous data or previous sexual behaviour studies.




## Demographics of the survey

Out of 300 questionnaires distributed in the schools of the six cities, 247 teachers accepted to be part of the study. This represents almost 4% of the total number of teachers in Albania.







Do you know the Law for the protection from the discrimination?




### Are you informed on the LGBTI rights?






### Have you witnessed discrimination in your school?

(Yes answers)






### Who was the victim of the discrimination?
















### Do students talk to you about their sexuality? (Yes Answers)






### Are the LGBTI adolescents victims of violence from their peers?






### What did you think or do when you were faced with cases of violence against LGBTI adolescents?











What is your opinion towards LGBTI adolescents?






### They are sick and they should seek treatment

(answers per gender in %)




