


WE ARE NOW WORKING IN 23 COUNTRIES

Through the Violence Against Children and Youth Surveys (VACS), we now have data for more than 10% of the world's children, adolescents, and young people







VACS METHODOLOGY

- National household survey
- Three-stage cluster sample survey design
- 13-24 year old males and females*
- Retrospective
- Carried out by in-country institutions
- Extensive efforts to protect respondents
- HIV testing and counselling (to respondents who can receive results on their own)



- The data presented here represent a small fraction of available VACS data








THE MAGNITUDE OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE AGAINST CHILDREN

% of youth who experienced sexual violence prior to age 18 as reported by 18-24 year olds



% of 13-17 year old girls who experienced sexual violence in the past 12 months






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
GIRLS ARE AT RISK FOR SEXUAL VIOLENCE THROUGHOUT CHILDHOOD & ADOLESCENCE

PERPETRATORS ARE OFTEN MORE THAN 5 YEARS OLDER THAN SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE


Perpetrator of sexual violence was more than 5 years older, among females ages 18-24 who experienced sexual violence before age 18 (%)





INTIMATE PARTNERS ARE OFTEN PERPETRATORS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE


Intimate partner was perpetrator of first incident of sexual violence, among females who experienced any sexual violence before age 18 (%)

Disclosure and service usage by those who experienced sexual violence prior to age 18, as reported by 18 to 24 year olds females*








THE MAGNITUDE OF PHYSICAL VIOLENCE AGAINST CHILDREN


% of 13-17 year-old girls who experienced physical violence in the past 12 months

% of 13-17 year-old girls who were physically harmed or injured* as a result of most recent experience of physical violence, among girls who experienced physical violence in past 12 months






Injuries from physical violence include: cuts, scratches, bruises, aches, redness or swelling or other minor marks; sprains, dislocations, or blistering; deep wounds, broken bones, broken teeth, or blackened or charred skin; and permanent injury or disfigurement.

% of 13-17 year-old girls who witnessed physical violence in the home or in the community/neighborhood in the past 12 months






Witnessing physical violence in the home includes: hearing or seeing a parent punch, kick or beat your other parent, their boyfriend or girlfriend, or your brothers or sisters.

Witnessing physical violence in the neighborhood includes: seeing someone get attacked outside of your home and family environment.



SUICIDE IDEATION AMONG ADOLESCENT GIRLS


% of 13-17 year old girls who reported thoughts of suicide, by whether they did or did not experience sexual violence in the past 12 months





INFREQUENT CONDOM USE AND HISTORY OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE IN CHILDHOOD


% of young women (19-24 years) with infrequent condom use in the last 12 months, by whether they did or did not experience sexual violence prior to age 18

% of 13-24 year-olds who became pregnant as a result of coerced or physically forced sex, among 13- to 24-year-olds who experienced coerced or physically forced sex






Association between childhood violence and physical IPV in young adulthood among 18-24 year old Kenyan females

Association between experiencing any type of childhood violence and sexual or physical violence perpetration among 13-24 year olds





% of 13-24 year-olds who attended school** and experienced one or more forms of physical and sexual violence perpetrated by teachers and/or classmates






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SEXUAL VIOLENCE PERPETRATED BY CLASSMATES

% of 13-24 year-olds** who attended school and experienced one or more forms of sexual violence perpetrated by classmates



% of 13-24 year-olds** who attended school and experienced one or more forms of sexual violence perpetrated by teachers








% of 13-24 year-olds** who attended school and missed school as a result of any physical violence experienced during childhood by a classmate






