SYNTHESIS - FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS, Contribution MIR-CRCH

(REPARATIONS) Blacks are not a vacuum. UNESCO has been at the forefront by registering as a world heritage the culture of the pygmies and the CHARTER OF MANDEN, which reflect a lived perception of the uniqueness of creation. It is important to mention this in the World Declaration.

(REPARATIONS) Reparations are not help. This is not a 'Marshall Plan'. It is a due. It is up to the recipients to decide on their management.

(MENTACID) What we expect from the FORUM: that it strives to change within the UN the translation in French of HUMAN RIGHTS by DROIT DE L'HUMAIN or DROITS HUMAINS. The question is a priority for us and very topical. In 2011 in France, the Minister of Education Luc Chatel asks that the Declaration of 1789 be affixed in schools (declaration which excludes Women, Blacks, Foreigners, and the Poor who can neither elect nor be elected); not the Universal Declaration of 1948.

(MENTACID) What we expect from the FORUM: that it be able to recall the prominent role of people of African descent in the institution & implementation of the corpus of individual and collective 'Human Rights' (right to sovereignty) in world wide.

(MENTACID) What we expect from the FORUM: a firm commitment to exposing falsifications of history & to lobbying for the media and educational institutions to rectify what needs to be corrected.

(GENOCID) What we expect from the FORUM: that it exert all its weight to criminalize the practice of prohibiting the distribution of risky products or practices on its soil, while tolerating or promoting their export.

(PROTECTION OF THE VANGUARD) What we expect from the FORUM: to help protect human rights defenders, and to press for the release of all equality defenders still locked up in American prisons. Mumia Au Jamal's case being emblematic.
