Thank you and good evening distinguished ladies and gentlemen, all protocols duly observed

My name is Kamil Olufowobi and I represent Most Influential People of African Descent (MIPAD) a youth focused global organization working in support of the Decade to get the next generation involved in this work to combat racism and all forms of discrimination against people of African descent worldwide.
