



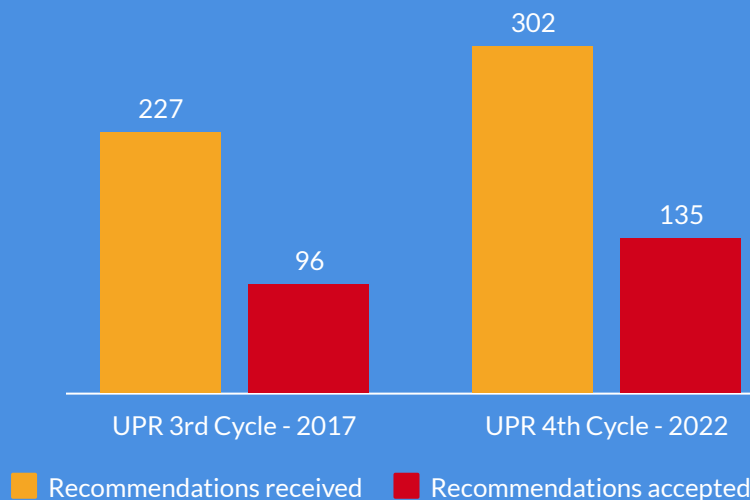

The Universal Periodic Review

United Kingdom was reviewed by UPR WG 41, in November of 2022. It received 302 recommendations and it supported 135 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at Human Rights Council 52, in March 2023 (an increase of 40.62% with respect to the 3rd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, International humanitarian law, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, children's rights and rights of other specific groups and persons.

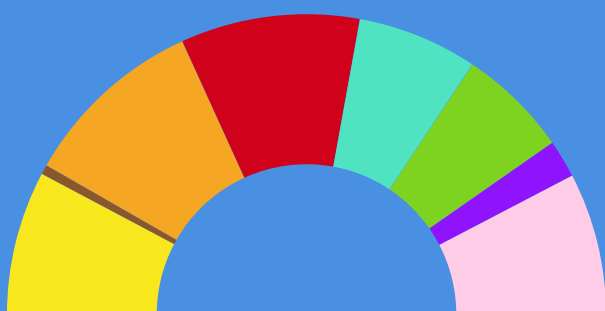
