



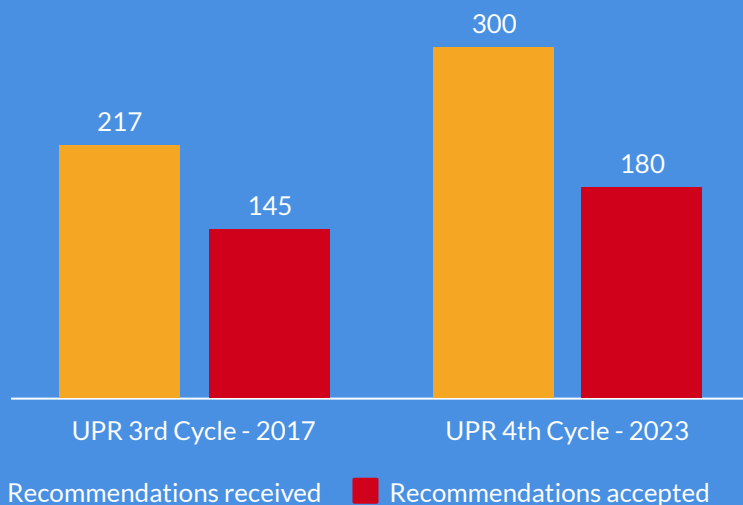
Japan

The Universal Periodic Review

Japan was reviewed by UPR WG 42, in January of 2023. It received 300 recommendations and it supported 180 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at Human Rights Council 53, in July 2023 (an increase of 24,137% with respect to the 3rd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, international humanitarian law, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, children's rights and rights of other specific groups and persons.
