



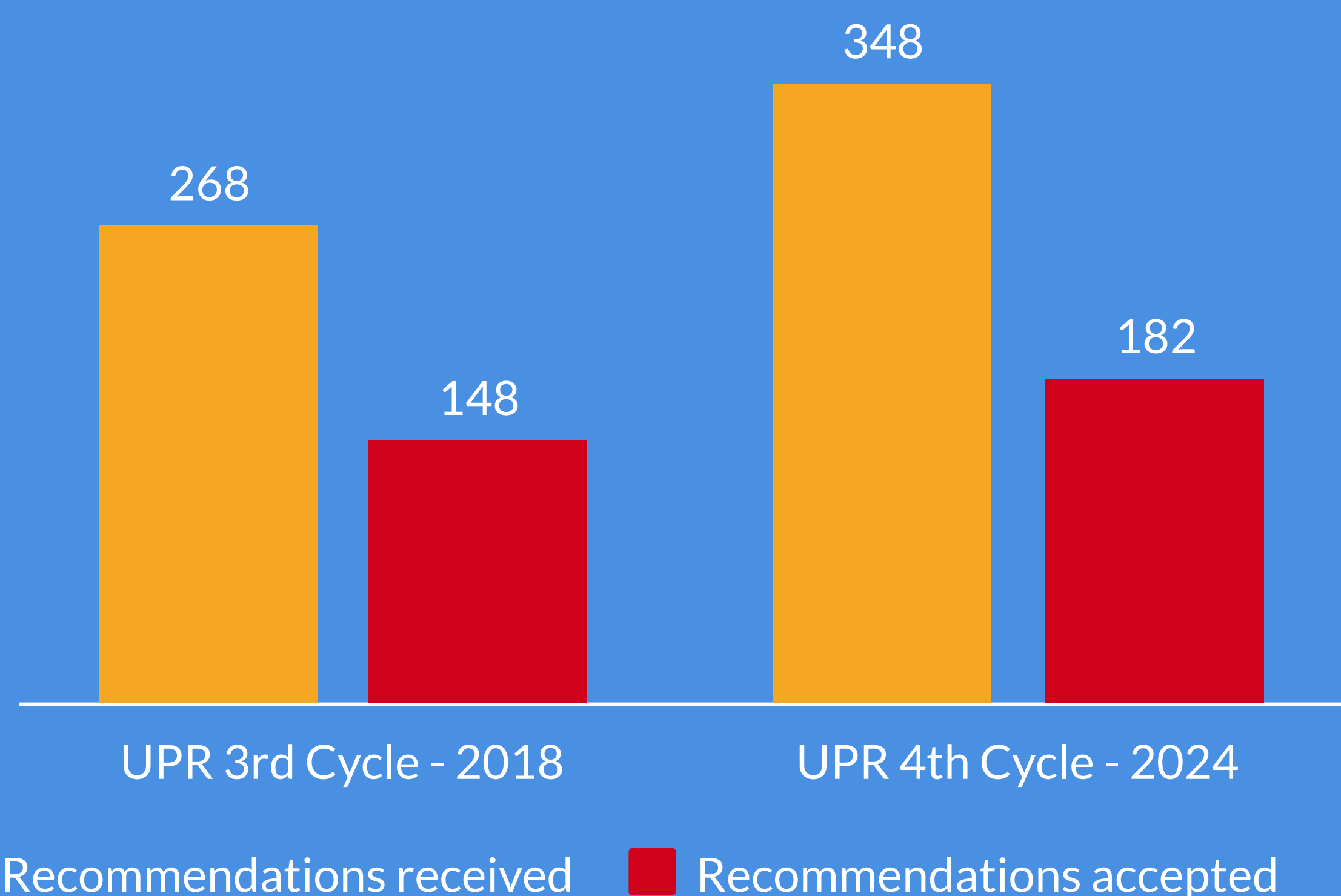
Malaysia

The Universal Periodic Review

Malaysia was reviewed by UPR WG 45, in January 2024. It received 348 recommendations and it supported 182 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at Human Rights Council 56, in July 2024 (an increase of 23% with respect to the 3rd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, and rights of other vulnerable groups and persons.
