Contribution of the Government of the Republic of Iraq on the subject of COVID-19 recovery plans and policies from the right to development perspective.

Ministry of Planning 's perspective on the subject of COVID recovery plans and policies from the right to development perspective, according to the response and the recovery plan from the repercussions of the Covid-19 crisis that was approved by the Council of Ministers in the session (33) on 31/08/2021, and as follows

The National Perspective:

• The first question:

Measures have been taken through an implementation plan aiming at rapid response and recovery from the effects of the Corona virus, in line with the basic directions drawn by the United Nations as paths to recovery, as well as placing rights holders in the operations Center. Recovery plans from Corona have been shared with specialists from university professors with medical and community specializations and the involvement of civil society organizations guidelines regarding drugs used for prevention and sending medical aid.

• The third question

The best way to intensify cooperation between countries and development agencies is through knowledge exchange, technical cooperation and capacities building for medical and technical staff in countries where afflicted cases are increasing, as well as the transfer of technology in the medical field.
