The Permanent Mission of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana to the United Nations Office and other International Organisations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Office of the Secretariat United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights and has the honour to refer to the request for contributions by Mr. Gerard Quinn, the Special Rapporteur on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities to his thematic report to the General Assembly that will be presented later this year.

The Permanent Mission wishes to inform, on behalf of the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs and Governance, the following:

1. The Government of Guyana has taken note of the request from the UN Special Rapporteur (SR), which is aimed at concluding a series of thematic reports focusing heavily on the peacebuilding processes in the context of armed conflicts and military and peacekeeping operations.

2. In light of the objective of the request for inputs and the report the inputs will inform, the Special Rapporteur is informed that the content is not relevant to Guyana given that the country does not have a history of armed conflict in the context of the SR's request.

3. The Government of Guyana extends best wishes to the SR in the preparation of his thematic report.

The Permanent Mission of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana to the United Nations Office and other International Organisations in Geneva avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretariat of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights the assurances of its highest consideration.
