

A brief reference to the aid provided by the Republic of Azerbaijan to the State of Palestine

- In December 2023, \$2,000,000 was donated to UNRWA for providing aid to civilians in the Gaza strip facing the humanitarian crises.
- In April 2023, in response to the joint appeal of the Secretary General of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) and the head of UNRWA, \$50,000 was allocated to support the activities of the Developmental Waqf Fund for the Palestinian Refugees;
- In 2022, in response to the request from the UN Secretary General, \$88,235 (150,000 manats) was donated to UNRWA;
- In 2021, in response to the appeal of the OIC Secretary General, \$200,000 was donated to UNRWA to help eliminate the socio-economic difficulties caused by the pandemic in Palestine;
- In 2020, in response to the OIC Secretary General's appeal, \$300,000 was donated to UNRWA to support efforts against the pandemic in Palestine;
- In 2018, a contribution of \$200,000 was made to UNRWA;
- In 2014, a financial contribution of \$637,512 (500,000 manats) was allocated to UNRWA in order to provide financial assistance to Palestine due the humanitarian crisis and the dire situation in the Gaza region resulting from Israel's military operations;
- In 2012, a financial contribution of \$100,000 was allocated to UNRWA due to the humanitarian situation in the Gaza region of Palestine.

Other aid provided to Palestine:

- In 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2022, Palestinian students benefited from the education grant programs for citizens of OIC and NAM member countries, established by the relevant decrees of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan;
- In 2018 and 2019, Palestinian diplomats participated in advanced training courses for diplomats of foreign countries at ADA University, organized by Azerbaijan International Development Agency (AIDA).
