



FORMAL AGREEMENT

BETWEEN SHINE SA and

 High School

Congratulations on becoming a Relationships and Sexual Health Education *focus school*. The overall aim of SHINE SA's support for schools is to improve the sexual health, wellbeing and safety of young people in South Australia.

By agreeing to be a Relationships and Sexual Health Education *focus school* you are agreeing to undertake the following activities:

- Curriculum delivery of 15 lessons of relationships and sexual health education in at least 2 year levels from 8 to 10 in 2020 – 2022.
- The curriculum will be based on the best practice model developed by SHINE SA.
- All teachers who will be involved in teaching the curriculum plus Student Counsellors will attend 15 hours of professional development provided by SHINE SA.
- All teachers who deliver the curriculum will be required to provide feedback on lessons that have been taught.
- Schools will ensure that Relationships and Sexual Health becomes a focus for the existing Student Health and Wellbeing Team and to ensure relationships and sexual health is supported in a whole school approach.
- Participation in evaluation activities as required by SHINE SA.
- Identify and support a key teacher who will maintain regular contact with the SHINE SA's School Coordinator.
- Inform the Department for Education and SHINE SA of any issues of concern, particularly those that could negatively effect the successful implementation of the program.

SHINE SA will offer the following support and resources for each Relationships and Sexual Health Education *focus school*:

- A package of resources including teacher year level books developed by SHINE SA will be provided to the school free of charge to support the curriculum delivery in 2020.
- Support for the primary years, Aboriginal students and students with special needs where applicable.
- A dedicated Schools Coordinator to provide professional development and to plan, implement and evaluate the program.
- Support to run parent information evenings.
- Free membership with the SHINE SA Library and Resource Centre in 2020.

Other terms:

This agreement is for 2020 to 2022. After these three years, future support will continue as negotiated. If at any time a school decides that they are not able to continue as a Relationships and Sexual Health Education *focus school* they need to speak with their Schools Coordinator about their concerns.

If a school has any concerns or grievances that they are not able to resolve satisfactorily with their Schools Coordinator they should write directly to the Chief Executive Officer of SHINE SA, PO Box 76, Woodville SA 5011.
