Input for SR VAWG's report on violence against women and girls in sport.

The Sports Confederation of Denmark (DIF) is a unifying organization for both elite and grassroots at the association level in Denmark. DIF is the main organization for 62 different national sports federations and about 9.000 local member clubs with over 2 million members – more than 1/3 of the Danish population. DIF supports the national federations and advocate for the role of sport in society.

In general, DIF does not keep independent data on violence against women and girls in sport, and DIF has no indication that violence against women and girls is a separate issue in Danish sport. DIF does not receive reports of violence among women and girls from our national sports federations or local clubs.

DIF has a whistleblower scheme and generally high trust in the police, where anyone can report violence. DIF does not experience that people are afraid to contact the police in this type of case. At DIF, we have a contact person to handle cases of sexual violations.

DIF helps and motivates the 62 national sports federations to ensure that policies are implemented and discrimination prevented, e.g. through a ethical code of conduct.
