No. 7/20/67-POL 1 (Pt): - Whereas there has been unprecedented increase in the commission of crimes, such as killing of innocent persons and Police and paramilitary personnel, robbery, dacoity, arson, sedition, offences under the Arms Act, harboring and rescuing of criminals, terrorizing peaceful and law – abiding citizens, disturbing the normally of life and public tranquility, endangering the lives of Civil authorities and attempts and incitement to commit the above offences and also violation of the provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 together with successions activities by unlawful elements in such areas of the State of Manipur as are described in the Schedule hereinafter appended; and

Whereas the Governor of Manipur is of the opinion that the aforesaid areas on account of the eruption of violence and crimes, as herein –before mentioned, are in such disturbed and dangerous condition that the use of the Armed Forces in aid of the Civil Powers is necessary, and

Whereas the Governor of Manipur consider that the aforesaid areas should be declare to be disturbed areas under the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958.

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by section 3 of the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958, the Governor of Manipur hereby declares the aforesaid areas to be disturbed areas with immediate effect until further order.

## **SCHEDULE**

Entire Manipur Central District except Jiribam Sub Division for which a separate notification has already been published under section 3 of the Armed Forces (Assam and Manipur) Special Powers Act, 1958 (28 of 1958), vide Government of Manipur Notification No. 7/2/67 – Pol.I
