The summary about the situation in Cuba is:

Cuba is a third world country under pressure and boycott,  
confronted with a cold war of the most powerful country  
of the world, the USA.

Cuba is a high developed thirdworld country.

Education and the schoolsystem is on a highlevel.  
Especially the schools for children with special needs.  
The first school for children with special needs in Havana,  
founded in 1992 was visited from the delegation on 9<sup>th</sup> of April 2012.

The situation of women is equal to the situation of men.

In April an UNO campaign for gayrights was organised  
from political and massorganistions in Cuba.  
Thats an outstanding occurence in an latinamerican country.

Nobody in Cuba is suffering of malnourishment.

The healthcaresystem is in an excellent condition.  
The delegation was deeply impressed of the ELAM  
(Escuela Latinamericano de Medicina) where 1.900 students,  
all from poor familys, from different american and african countrys get  
for free a qualification as medical scientists.

All officials, the delegation mets, answered openly without tabus  
to the questions of the delegation.  
Especially all questions to the process of renewing the social and economical  
life, called „Update“ where broad answered and discussed.
