

BKTF is a coalition of twenty two local and international non-governmental organizations. BKTF established in February 2002, is working in Albania to fight child trafficking and exploitation and to assist and protect vulnerable children.

The purpose of the Coalition is to join efforts and advocate for the development of national strategies against child trafficking, establishment and enforcement of child protection mechanisms and improvement of services delivered to children, who are victims of trafficking, abuse or exploitation as well as at risk children.

BKTF considers the problem of child trafficking in the wider context of child protection. The human rights of the child are at the basis of BKTF's engagement. The overall leitmotiv of the Coalition is to act with determination and devotion in accordance with the principle of “the best interest of the child”.

BKTF is actively involved in monitoring the National Strategy for the Fight against Child Trafficking and the Protection of Child Victims of Trafficking. The Coalition is deeply involved in lobbying and conducting advocacy campaigns for children's rights with particular focus on the fight against child exploitation, child abuse and child trafficking.
