

## **ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO GRENADA**

### **DENMARK**

- Which measures will the government of Grenada take to prohibit corporal punishment in the home, in schools and in all other settings?
- What will be done to end the criminalization of sexual activity between consenting adults of the same sex?
- Which interventions are being implemented to counteract human trafficking?
- Denmark would very much appreciate an indication as to whether Grenada is considering becoming a signatory to CAT in the near future. What are the government's plans in this regard?

### **LATVIA**

- According to the information by the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, 67 countries from different regions of the world have issued standing invitations to all special procedures of the Human Rights Council. While no requests have been made by special procedures mandate holders to visit Grenada – would your country consider extending a standing invitation to all special procedures of the Human Rights Council in the future?

### **SLOVENIA**

- We would like to know whether the Government has taken any steps towards establishing an independent national human rights institution, in accordance with the Paris Principles.

### **UNITED KINGDOM**

- Could you please provide information on the extent to which civil society was consulted in the preparation of your national report?
- We would be grateful to know what progress has been made in establishing an independent national human rights institution in Grenada that operates in accordance with the Paris principles designed to guide the practice of such institutions?
- Please could you tell us what progress Grenada has made in meeting its reporting and examination requirements under the treaties to which it is party?
- Could you please explain what progress has been made to amend legislation to ensure that both boys and girls are provided equal and adequate protection against

all forms of sexual abuse and exploitation in line with CRC recommendation from 2000?

- We would be interested to learn what progress has been made on juvenile justice standards especially on the provision of juvenile courts and the separation of children from adults in both pre and post trial detention centres and steps taken to address overcrowding in prisons more generally?
- Please could you tell us what steps the Government has taken to reduce instances of domestic violence especially against women?
- We would be grateful to know whether Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender people in Grenada enjoy equal access to healthcare and other public amenities without discrimination and whether the Government will consider repealing legislation that criminalises sexual activity between consenting adults of the same sex?
