

High Level LGBT Core Group Event¹ "Leaving No-one Behind: Equality & Inclusion in the Post-2015 Development Agenda" Tuesday, 29 September 2015

The purpose of the event is to raise awareness of the challenges facing members of the LGBT community around the world, and to highlight the linkages between LGBT inclusion and the pace of social and economic development. The UN Secretary General, a former Head of State and a leading activist of the human rights movement will reflect on the importance of leadership in challenging discriminatory attitudes towards LGBT people and taking steps to end human rights violations against them.

¹The LGBT Core Group is a cross regional group that includes Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Chile Colombia, Croatia, El Salvador, France, Israel, Japan, Montenegro, The Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Uruguay, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America, the European Union, as well as the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights, Human Rights Watch and International Gay and Lesbian Human Rights Commission
